With the permission and co-operation of the State Government, POST & TELEGRAPH OFFICES will be established within the South-east and North-east Pylons of the Sydney Harbour Bridge. These Offices will be open from March 19th to April 2nd.

Souvenir Telegrams.

Souvenir Telegrams may be lodged at either Pylon Post-office and collected, on application, at the Post-office at the opposite end of the Bridge. The Telegrams will be issued on attractive forms, specially designed for the occasion and enclosed in special envelopes. Souvenir Telegrams may also be sent from any Post-office in Australia to any address in the Commonwealth. Such messages however, should bear the instruction "Post Sydney Harbour Bridge". The usual telegraph rates will apply. The Sydney Harbour Bridge special date stamp will appear on all telegrams delivered or forwarded from either of the Sydney Harbour Bridge Post-offices.

Harbour Bridge Stamps.

The special issue of Harbour Bridge Postage Stamps will be on sale in the Pylon Post-offices and posting receptacles will be provided. Only mail matter posted at the Bridge will bear the imprint of the SPECIAL CANCELLATION STAMP which will add so greatly to the value from a philatelic and memento viewpoint.

Public Telephones.

Public Telephones will be available at each Post-office, special arrangements being made to deal with long-distance telephone calls.

ENTRANCE TO THE POST-OFFICES will be obtained via the stairway provided at the footway level in each Pylon.

Money Order and Savings Bank business will NOT be transacted.
